The Citizen Portal is your one stop shop to:

- Register to vote (Deadline Oct. 15)
- Change your name or address (by Oct 15)
- Verify your polling location
- Find your election districts
- Apply for an absentee ballot by mail

EARLY VOTING (In-person Absentee Voting)

If you work outside of Fairfax County; will be outside of the County at all on Election Day; are ill, disabled, or pregnant; are a first responder; are active duty military or spouse; go to school outside the County; or one of many other reasons, you may vote absentee before Election Day.

Absentee ballots by mail may be requested via the Citizen Portal. All completed absentee ballots must be **received** by the Office of Elections by 7:00 pm on November 5, 2019. **Late ballots will not be counted.**

Tuesday, October 29 is the last day to request an absentee ballot by mail.
